

# Frequently Asked Questions

## Can I get a plate for a leased vehicle?

Yes.

## Can I get a plate for a commercial vehicle or motorcycle?

Sorry, no.

## Can I choose letters and numbers? (ex. CN39)

No, numbers only.

## Can I get a low number plate?

## Can I get any number I request?

No. I can only give out plates 1-3000. Anything over 3000 will be given out by the RMV and please note they do not take requests.

## Can you put a "0" in front of the numbers? (ex 0305)

No. 0305 will print as 305

## Can anyone get these?

Yes, everyone who supports law enforcement is encouraged to get these.

## What if my check expires during the process?

We do not deposit the checks until the 3000 applications are accepted. If your check expires before this time I will email you to send another check and shred the expired check. You may also leave the date blank should you choose.

## How long until I can get my plate?

This will depend on how quickly we gather the 3000 applications so please spread the word! Once we get the 3000 applications it will take 3 months to produce and you will be notified once yours is available at the RMV.
