

PCBH club Big Buck / Big Doe Award

1. All entries shall be harvested by bow and arrow in compliance with the laws of Illinois. (No crossbow taken deer will be allowed.)
2. All entries must be harvested and entered by a Panther Creek Bowhunter member in good standing.
3. All deer entered shall have been taken in the season immediately previous to the March deadline.
4. There will be two categories, Big Buck and Big Doe.
5. Big Doe Award
 - A. Award will be given for the largest doe by body weight after field dressing.
 - B. The doe should be weighed on a respectable scales and witnessed by one non-family member.
 - C. Weight slip and a **picture** of the animal should be given/sent to the club president at or before the March club meeting.

6. Big Buck award
 - A. Award will be based on an official Pope and Young score.
 - B. The highest net score will be the determining factor.
 - C. Both Typical and Non-Typical antlers will compete for the same award.
 - D. Should there be an entry from each antler category, the winner will be the one in the highest percentage ranking listed in a recent Pope and Young book.
 - E. A copy of the official score sheet and a **picture** should be given/sent to the club president at or before the next March club meeting. (info@panthercreekbowhunters.com)
7. The name of the winning hunter will be engraved on the trophy.
The winning hunter will be allowed to have the trophy until the following February meeting or before. A refundable \$20 deposit shall be paid by the winning hunter up on taking the trophy. This \$20 will be refunded on the return of the trophy.
