




Santa Clause with JB



Starsky and Hutch Gran Torino

In 1975, Spelling-Goldberg Productions broadcast a new TV cop show called Starsky and Hutch. The show was created by William Blinn, airing on ABC, from 1975 to 1979. The show had three big stars; Paul Michael Glaser, Starsky; David Soul, Hutch; and a 1975 Red & White Gran Torino called Zebra 3.

Originally, William Blinn was to have Starsky drive a green & white Chevrolet Camaro convertible because he fondly remembered the one he had owned. However, when production started on the pilot episode, Ford Motor Company's Loan Program was the lease supplier for Spelling-Goldberg. As a result, they looked at their lease stock and chose two 1975 351 Windsor V8-powered "Bright Red" (paint code 2B) 2-door Gran Torinos. Both cars had a role in the pilot episode/movie.

The cars were also custom painted (on top of the factory red paint color) with the distinctive white "vector" stripe designed by Spelling-Goldberg's transportation coordinator George Grenier. The two Torinos used in the pilot movie, the Torinos used in the TV show, the Ford factory 1976 Torinos, and the Torinos used in the 2004 movie all had a different white strip.

The rear ends of the cars were lifted by air shocks and had Ansen Sprint 5-slot mag wheels added with larger rear tires. The tires were mounted so that only the black wall side would show, thus hiding any unauthorized brand-name display.

Approximately 27 Torinos were used in the TV series. The cars popularity was so great, Ford produced approximately 1,000 cars to be sold to the public. Orders were taken at the local Ford Dealerships with production beginning in March, 1976, at the Chicago, Illinois assembly plant.

Other than the custom paint, there isn't anything else special about the car. Of the 1,000 cars produced in 1976, there were different engine, transmission (C4 or C6), and interior packages. Basically, a white car was pulled off of the assembly line, the strip was taped off, and the car was painted red. This procedure was different than the one used for the TV cars. The documentation on the driver's door, a metal plate on the passenger side cowl and the build sheet all identify each car as a Starsky and Hutch Unit.

My car, the second Starsky & Hutch I have owned, is one of the 1,000 produced in 1976. It has a 460 ci motor, C6 automatic transmission (floor shift) and a 9-inch Posi-track rear-end (I believe it has 255 gears). I have had this car for over 10-years, I just haven't had the time and money to restore it to the way I want. My grandsons and I disassembled the car a long time ago discovering rust in the floor pans. That is the reason for the wood deck spanning the interior from door to door. I have collected parts through the years and have them stored in a room above this garage. My grandsons and I hope to start this project, this year. My oldest grandson can't wait to drive it. I'll cross that bridge when the time comes.
