Past events summary/update:

Sunday School News. Children 1st grade to 6th grade may now attend Sunday School with teachers. Infant to kindergarten are welcome in the nursery (Bible lesson included). Youth 7th grade and above please attend worship. Worship bags are available for children and teens remaining in worship. **Once a month the 7th grade and above will meet on Sunday night with Karine Carls for youth group!**

Church Safety. Recently concerns were brought to council about our building safety and safety policies. Staying safe as we gather for worship is an important matter that has become more apparent due to some break ins in our neighborhood and the concern for an active shooting scenario.

We do already have some safety practices in place such as replacing burned out parking lot lights to keep our worship space brightly lit at night, we have door ring systems with cameras so we see who enters and leaves the building, and the Kalamazoo police routinely patrol and stop in our parking lot.

In a continuing effort to assess safety concerns council has at their February meeting adopted the following changes for our door locks. Council has approved having the office side door lock changed and a limited number of non-copiable keys purchased. These keys will be primarily given to staff and those serving on service teams or council. Council has also approved the property service team assessing the main door locks and lower level locks and replacing, changing, or sealing them as they determine. The building will normally be open during weekly office hours Monday – Thursday 9:30-3:00 p.m. or you can arrange to meet someone with a key at the church to let you in. The doors will be open at least half an hour before worship on Sundays so access to the building for worship will not be affected.

These are some big changes for our congregation, but the hope is that they will help to make our building a safer place for us and guests/visitors to worship. Council will also continue to explore other safety concerns and options, and as always if you have any questions or ideas you are welcome to speak to any of your council members.


