Field Training Program - Alcatraz Island & Pearl Harbor

Program Overview

- Experience of a lifetime for post-9/11 military (active duty & veterans, reservists, guard) and, on limited basis, students
- · No prior experience required, great preparation regardless of career interest
- Significant repair projects on National Historic Landmark structures and Monuments
- · Participants connect with potential employers across the US
- · Led by CPI's expert staff and industry guest lectures
- · Three 12-week, full-time sessions each year at each location
- No program fees for military; student fees vary by session
- CPI is an official military Career Skills Program and partners with the US National Park Service

Employer Outlook

- · CPI's learning outcomes prepare participants with or without college degrees for jobs in many concrete- and constructionrelated fields
- · CPI uses their extensive industry & academic connections to link participants with employers across the US for skilled trade jobs, management-path careers, paid internships leading to jobs, and with college programs

Participants

- Earn 480 National Park Service volunteer hours
- · Complete OSHA course and receive OSHA Safety Certificate
- Concrete Industry professional certifications (see below)
- · Gain teamwork skills and a tremendous sense of accomplishment completing significant real-world projects
- · Gain leadership experience through project & logistics management, safety management, and public relations
- Develop hands-on skills in basic concrete construction/repair design, evaluation, and testing; project scheduling/estimating; tool/equipment operation and maintenance; wood carpentry; and concrete materials/mixing/placement/finishing
- Become knowledgeable about preservation and long-term stewardship of natural resources and the built environment
- · Learn from CPI, industry, academia, & NPS leading experts
- · Interact often with industry executives to learn and interview for jobs or internships
- · Participate in field trips to local project sites, manufacturing facilities, and business locations
- Give back by serving as mentors for local youth during CPI's community service activities
- · Join the growing CPI alumni network across the US

Alcatraz Island Program Specifics

- Training for International Concrete Repair Institute's (ICRI) Concrete Surface Repair Technician (CSRT) Certification (candidates are encouraged to register for the ICRI certification once they are in the workforce; some employers pay for the program) Partners are US National Park Service, Golden Gate National Parks Conservancy, industry companies
