

## **Range Safety Rules : BB Gun / Slingshot / Catapult**

- Tiger Scouts, MUST have their Adult Partner on the FIRING line.
- Range may ONLY be opened by a BSA trained Range Master who must remain on site while Range is OPEN.
- A Red Range Flag MUST be raised and visible whenever a range is open.
- NO shooting is allowed unless the Range Flag is Raised.
- Everyone at Ranges, MUST obey and follow ALL instructions from the Range Master.
- While the Range Master is giving instructions, everyone else must remain quiet.
- Anyone not behaving properly, not acting in a safe manner or not following ALL instructions from the Range Master will immediately be removed from Range.
- Eye Protection must be worn by everyone while in the firing line area.
- No running while at Ranges.
- A First Aid Kit MUST be on location and easily accessible on all OPEN Ranges.
- ALL Shooters must be familiar with the safe operation of their BB Gun, Slingshot or Catapult.
- Do Not Handle BB Guns, Slingshots, Catapults or Ammo until you have been instructed by Range Master and everyone is behind the firing line.
- ONLY use correct ammunition for your BB Gun, Slingshot or Catapult.
- Know YOUR target and what is beyond it. No one down range during shooting.
- **DO NOT SHOOT UNTIL INSTRUCTED BY RANGE MASTER.**

### **BB Guns :**

- Always keep BB Guns unloaded until ready to shoot.
- All BB Guns must be pointed down range at ALL times.
- Always keep fingers off BB Gun triggers and outside of trigger guards until ready to shoot.
- When instructed to CEASE FIRE : Completely open the cocking lever on your gun. Open the bolt. Lay down your gun on the mat with muzzle end pointing down range. Sit on the mat behind your gun and wait for further instructions.

### **Slingshot / Catapult :**

- Do not touch ammo until ready to shoot.
- When instructed to CEASE FIRE : Return ammo to the holder. Place Slingshot or Catapult on the ground. Stand and wait for further instructions.
