*Coordinated Entry: A system that provides a single or coordinated method by which people at risk of or currently experiencing homelessness can find and access shelter, housing and services. Typically, the intake process includes outreach, a basic assessment, initial system intake, and program referral /program placements.

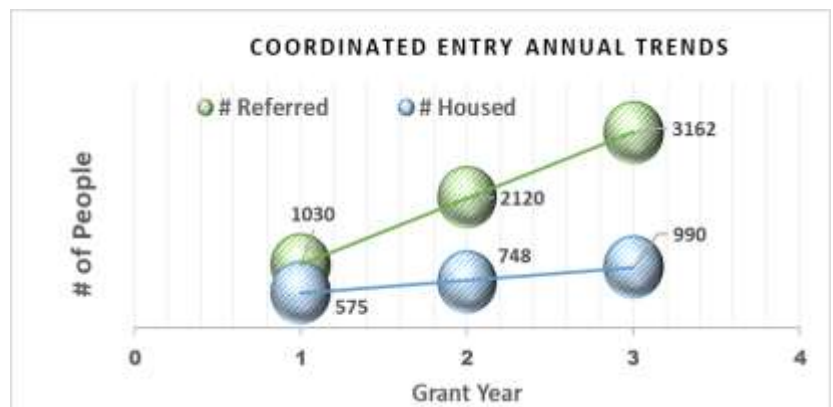
