Dear Friend,

Jeff Sill, a retired police officer and MMI board member, travelled with me on a two week trip to 5 countries. God blessed us beyond what we could have imagined on this trip. We met with our regional representative, Major Jorge Serna and with Clemente Sandoval, a Colombian pastor. We travelled to a remote part of Colombia where the Guerilla's are still active and shooting at the police.

We met a Lt Colonel who is a strong believer and who wants to help us with our future outreaches in Colombia. We trained and preached to 232 officers and saw many respond to the gospel.

We travelled to Costa Rica, El Salvador and Guatemala and trained and ministered to police officers with the help of our regional representatives in those countries. God is really blessing the police in Guatemala where there are police officers who are full time chaplains who minister to the police on a regular basis. We ministered to and trained 432 cops on this trip and saw about 325 respond to a gospel invitation.

In Mexico we met with a friend who was a congresswoman. Her husband pastors a church of 10,000 in Mexico City. She was working on setting up outreaches to the police for us in Mexico but nothing was coming together. As we were having lunch with her the Governor of Mexico City (which is a city state of 21 million people) called and asked to come by the restaurant. She said this never happens. When he showed up and met us he then set up a meeting with the chief of police of Mexico City

We met with the chief of police, the deputy chief and the 3rd in command that day. Their police department has 83,000 police officers and is the largest city police department in the world. They asked us to come and train and share with their police officers as often as we can.

I have been praying for 13 years for the opportunity to minister to this police department and in one day God opened the door. Thank you for your prayers and support.
