Ride Description

1. Field Parking. Water is available. Some stalls available for overnight stabling.
2. Estimated distance 7 miles or more of woodland trails, fields and dirt roads.
3. Terrain is mixed with some hills, some rocky conditions and some water crossings
4. Obstacles: There will be 10.... Some natural; some with working situations.
5. Horse/ Rider team will be judged –Same rider must ride same horse for 100% of ride
6. Sign in Table opens at 9:00 AM, First Riders out at 10:00 Horses will be dispatched in intervals to prevent major bunching at obstacles on trails. You may be dispatched in groups of 4, if desired.
7. You do not have to ride the judged obstacles to participate.

Ride Rules

1. You must be entered and have signed a waiver to participate. Horse/Rider enter as a team.
2. You must stay on marked trail. You can enter and ride this event without participating in the obstacle portion of the ride, but will not be eligible for the awards.
3. Safe riding practices are required. All riders must use saddles and helmets are requested. Judges will be taking your safety practices into consideration.
4. No more than 3 attempts at an obstacle, unless judge signals otherwise. There is a penalty for dismounting and walking/leading horse through obstacle.
5. All judges decisions are final. There are multiple judges judging this event.
6. Riders under the age of 14 must be accompanied by an adult.
7. Riders must display their entry number to all judges throughout the ride. Only riders participating in the judged obstacle are required to have a number.
8. Please be courteous to other riders at all times during ride. There may be moments on trail, where you will have to wait your turn to negotiate an obstacle. You are being judged at all times at an obstacle.
