


## GRAND PUP TENT Fertile Hunting Grounds of New Mexico

## MILITARY ORDER OF THE COOTIE

Of the United States









General Order Number 1 (2020-2021 Series)

June 6,2020

- 1. **ASSUMPTION OF COMMAND**: Under the provisions of Article IV Section 408 of the By-Laws of the Military Order of the Cootie, as amended by the 100<sup>th</sup> Supreme Scratch and dated July 27, 2020; and, having been duly elected at the Grand Scratch on the 5th of June 2016, I, Mark Decker, have assumed command of the Grand of New Mexico effective June 6, 2016 for the year 2020-2021.
- 2. **ELECTIONS AND APPOINTMENTS**: Grand Officers will wear the white tassels unless he or she has authority to wear a higher rank/grade tassel for the remainder of this year or on a permanent basis. All previously elected and appointed Grand Officers for 2019-2020 are hereby relieved of those duties, those Officers are reminded to ensure they are now wearing the proper tassels on their caps.
- 3. **GRAND ROSTER**: Any Grand Officer that has an email address not listed on the Grand Roster PLEASE contact the Grand Commander, or Hungry Cootie so the Roster can be updated and to ensure you are included on any email traffic.
- 4. **PUP TENT INSPECTIONS:** All Pup Tents will be visited by me as soon as possible. I do, however, reserve the right to change this itinerary as needed for unforeseen circumstances. Tentative schedule:

PT 7 LOCO July 11

PT 14 KIA-MIA Every month inspected by Past Grand Commander and Hungry Cootie at Mid-Winter Scratch

PT 19 ITCHIN' N BITCHIN' August 4

During these visits, Pup Tents will be inspected, so have any transmittals or donations prepared at that time. If we can not do the inspection at this time, bring all paperwork to Mid-Winter Scratch for inspection.

5. **GRAND COMMANDER SPECIAL PROJECT:** The Grand Commander's Special Project is to provide iPod music gift cards or small speakers for the Ipod's to the VA Hospital in Amarillo and Albuquerque inpatient units. Pup Tents are to take note of the obligatory \$2.00 per Cootie for the Grand Commander's Special Project, \$1.00 per Cootie for the Supreme Commander's Special

- Project, \$1.00 for the funding of MOC/MOCA Home at the National Home and \$1.00 per Cootie for the Scholarship Fund.
- 6. **SUPREME**: The Supreme Commander, Darin Combs, has selected "Increase and Multiply" as the 2020-2021 Theme for the Supreme MOC. The Supreme password will be released after the Supreme Convention.
- 7. **RENEW AND CHECK**: As we renew the annual memberships of the MOC, make sure the member is either a LIFE VFW member or that they have paid their dues for the year you are renewing them for MOC. Veterans who are not current in their VFW dues are not covered by the no-cost VFW insurance and they are not eligible for full VFW military honors at their funeral.
- 8. **HELP VFW MEMBERSHIP NOW**: Membership in the VFW is supreme and is the first priority of every Cootie. The more VFW members in a Post who are active workers, the more the Pup Tent has to choose from to invite to be a Cootie. Pup Tents need 9 members to remain viable. Any VFW member who is an *active worker* may, *by invitation*, become a prospective MOC member.
- 9. **CONFERENCES**: The Supreme Scratch in Reno, NV has been cancelled. The requirement for each Pup Tent is required to pre-register at least one delegate to the Supreme Scratch is under review at this time.
- 10. **EIN and FILE IRS FORM**: Pup Tents must have a current EIN and file IRS form 990 regardless on the amount of income. No EIN or filing your 990 means you are no longer a Charitable Unit and cannot accept donations.
- 11. **GRAND GOALS**: The following goals have been set; each Pup Tent and every Cootie is encouraged to do their part in achieving these goals:
  - 100% of Inspections to be completed before Mid-Winter Scratch.
  - 100% PLUS in Membership in each Pup Tent before the mid-winter conference.
  - 100% in National Home Project (\$1.00 per Cootie) by 31 December 2020.
  - 100% PLUS in Hospital Reports before the mid-winter conference.
  - 1 New Pup Tent this year.
- 12. **REPORTS**: Do not wait until the last minute to submit your Hospital Reports. It makes it very frustrating for the Chairmen's to constantly race just before the deadlines to get these reports in to the Supreme Chairmen. Give yourselves just credit for the work you do.
- 13. **PUP TENT REQUIREMENTS**: Pup Tents are reminded that: reports of audits should be forwarded as soon as the audit is complete; when a Cootie dies, immediately notify the Grand Chaplain and the Grand Quartermaster; bonding of the CCDB is required; and the mail box for membership transmittals is always open, don't delay reports until a special event.
- 14. **WORKING WITH OTHER ORGANIZATIONS**: MOC Grand of New Mexico is part of the VFW Department of New Mexico. We must be VFW first, then MOC. Work with the VFW at Post District and Department to accomplish all VFW goals. We also have a co-organization we work with. The MOCA Grand of New Mexico is here to help us in our programs and work. But we must be there to help them also. Work hand in hand with the MOCA at Pup Tent and Grand level to accomplish all of our goals. If you have trouble or disputes with any of these organizations, bring them up to either the Grand Commander or the Grand Hungry Cootie right away. We will try to see what is the problem and come to a resolution about the problem.

- 15. **SUPREME COMMANDER'S BOOK**: The MOC Supreme Commander's "Program Book 2020-2021" is included in the *Cootie Courier*.
