

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE THE USE OF FIREARMS,
PELLET GUNS, AIR GUNS AND SLING SHOTS, AND TO
PROVIDE FOR PUNISHMENT FOR VIOLATION THEREOF

The Village of Dryden ordains:

- Section 1. No person, except in the discharge of some duty required by law, or by written permission of the Village Council, shall discharge any cannon, gun, pistol or other firearm, or discharge any pellet gun, air gun (BB gun) or sling shot within the corporate limits of the Village of Dryden.
- Section 2. Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction thereof, shall be subject to a fine of not less than Five (\$5.00) Dollars nor more than One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars and costs, or by imprisonment in the county jail for the County of Lapeer not exceeding ninety (90) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.
- Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days from the date of passage thereof.
