



Scholarship Criteria

For

The Walter H. Scott Memorial Scholarship Fund

- Purpose:** The WHSMSF awards annual financial scholarships to college-bound high school student-athletes based on demonstrated academic achievement, financial need, and an express interest in obtaining higher education.
- Criteria:** The student-athletes eligible for assistance must be a graduating high school student-athlete of Troup County Schools who has lettered at least one year in one sport and maintained at least a Cum. GPA of 2.5. In addition, student-athletes must continue their education at a four-year college or university. Consideration will be given to academic achievement, financial need, and the student's community service record.
- Guidelines:** Scholarship recipients will be notified by Friday, May 1, 2020. Funds will be disbursed on Friday, July 10, 2020. Student-athletes must be enrolled in a college or university.
- Amount:** Each scholarship awarded will be a minimum of \$500.
- Deadline:** The application deadline is April 17, 2020. The deadline is the date after which applications will no longer be accepted. The Selection Committee uses the postmarked date to determine mailed entries.
