2018 Teen Summer Reading Program Guidelines

1. Teens grades 7-12 (including 2018 graduating seniors) may register for the program June 4-June 23.
2. There will be five weeks of reading from June 18 – July 23.
3. Participants are encouraged to read books at or above their reading level.
4. Books must be checked out from the Pigeon District Library, at least overnight.
5. Books must be recorded on each person’s Reading Log and returned to the Circulation Desk during regular library hours.
6. Reading Logs must be brought to the library each time books are returned.
7. For every 10 books which are read, recorded, and returned by Monday July 23, readers may pick 1 prize. Readers may earn up to 3 prizes (30 books). Every 100 pages count as one book.
8. After earning 3 prizes, participants may enter 1 ticket for every 10 books that have been read, recorded, and returned by the program deadline. These tickets will be put into a special drawing for prizes at the SRP party.
9. The last day to return books and reading logs for program credit and get prizes is Monday, July 23.
10. Every Thursday, there will be a program at the library. *See Program Calendar for details.*
11. Participants will be invited to the Reading Program Party on Thursday, August 2nd at 5:30 PM with Pizza, Ice Cream and LIVE music!
12. If unable to attend the party, participants may pick up their certificate of completion at the library before August 16.
