## Life

Did you know that <u>every living thing on earth exists because of a four-letter code</u> written in <u>nucleic acids</u>: A (<u>a</u>denine), T (<u>t</u>hymine), G (<u>g</u>uanine), and C (<u>c</u>ytosine). It is called <u>DNA</u> (<u>deoxyribonucleic acid</u>). <u>DNA</u> looks exactly the same in every organism on Earth.<sup>1</sup>

The <u>DNA code</u> is the <u>genetic blueprint of a cell</u>, along with <u>instructions for the functions</u> <u>of the cell</u>. The actual structure of the DNA molecule, and how it codes for proteins, is the same from bacteria to yeast to plants and animals – and humans. Nucleic acids are key macromolecules in the continuity of life.

People are usually told that it is the order of the four letters that makes <u>3 million species</u> different.<sup>2</sup> But it is important to also understand that <u>those 3 million species make up one thing</u> – <u>life on earth</u>. They are interconnected and interdependent on each other.

- Animals and humans are dependent on plants and trees for oxygen.
- Plants and trees are dependent on animals and humans for carbon dioxide.
- <u>Humans</u> are dependent on <u>trillions of microorganisms</u> (bacteria), that inhabit just about every part of the human body -- *living on the skin, in the gut, and up the nose --* survival and *play a vital role in human health.*
- Trillions of microorganisms are dependent on each human for their survival.3
- It is the order of the four letters that determine everything's place in "life."

Without DNA there is no life on earth!

A <u>genome</u> is the <u>complete DNA code</u> for a species. The human genome has <u>3 billion</u> <u>letters</u>. <u>Sickle-cell anemia</u> is caused by <u>a mutation in a single letter</u>. The mutation causes a kink in the hemoglobin protein. Oxygen does not get to tissues and organs, causing severe pain, and in most cases, death by age fifty. This disease afflicts more than four million people worldwide. Today, the <u>CRISPR-Cas9 gene editing tool</u> can find the letter with the mutation and correct it. There will be many other diseases cured by CRISPR tools in the near future.<sup>4</sup>

- The average human body contains approximately 37.2 trillion cells.
- The body replaces itself with <u>a largely new set of cells every 7 to 10 years</u>.
- Every one of those trillions of cells contains a complete DNA code for creating a human body.




