Some Important Updates from Fr. Balash

Diocesan Regionalization and Restructuring Plan

As announced last week the Diocese is moving forward on a new plan of Parish Regionalization to better focus attention and resources in light of the given realities of population, Catholic affiliation and participation, and the aging demographic of priests. Each parish has been placed into a pastoral region. Parishes in each region have been asked to come together to discuss challenges and opportunities for collaborating in administration, ministry and worship. Saint William Parish is part of the Trumbull North Region along with St. Thomas the Apostle Parish, Vienna and St. Robert Parish, Cortland. An essential aspect of the pastoral regions is to reduce the burden on priests. Each region has been assigned a specific number of priests based on the number available and the number of people attending Mass. Other ways of collaborating and sharing ministry are also to be explored not only within a particular region but in the surrounding area. It is anticipated that St. William will continue to participate in already established events and opportunities we now have with other parishes in Warren along with exploring new possibilities. In the coming weeks and months, I will update you on any further developments.

Bishop Murry Health Update

This week we received an update from Bishop Murry regarding his health. Sadly, he has relapsed and his leukemia has returned. It is not as intense as last year, but nonetheless it needs attention. Bishop Murry entered the Cleveland Clinic on Wednesday for a 28-day program of chemotherapy. The goal is to prepare him for a bone marrow transplant in September which is believed to be the best way to prevent another occurrence of the cancer. I kindly ask that you please keep Bishop Murry and all those battling cancer or illness in your daily prayers.

Changing the Words of the "Lord's Prayer"

Some have asked about a recent news story indicating that Pope Francis was going to change the words of the "Lord's Prayer." I am happy to provide the following clarification. On June 6, the secular media reported that Pope Francis "changed" the text of the Lord's Prayer from "lead us not into temptation" to "do not let us fall into temptation." Pope Francis rightfully stated that God never leads us into temptation. Not surprisingly, many have wondered when the "new translation of the Lord's Prayer" will take place. As a matter of point, a new translation of a liturgical text will never be announced through the secular media. What happened is that many of the news outlets reported on a translation in Europe and erroneously extended it to the United States. The Conference of Bishops in Italy recently approved this translation and Pope Francis approved this edition and was explaining his approval of the new translation of the Lord's Prayer for Italy and the theology behind it. (Note: In other languages, too, the phrase better translates into "do not let us fall into temptation."). In 2010, the United States Bishops voted to keep the traditional translation. The Lord's Prayer, as it is currently said, remains the official translation for the dioceses of the United States and currently there is no plan to alter the current version.

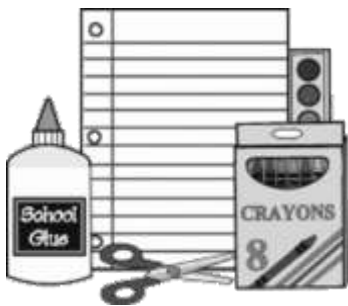
