THRIFT STORE NOTE

Too many folks are using our Thrift Store as a depository for items large and small that are **not** in any condition to be accepted or sold. This places an enormous, extra unwelcomed burden on our few volunteers to have to work through and deal with. Our volunteers also have to bear the weight and cost of loading and hauling huge amounts of these flawed items to the dump. It's not right, it's not fair!

Furthermore, leaving unattended donations in front of the gate or on the pews outside, is not only an unwelcomed eyesore, but also **very disrespectful to our church** and volunteers.

1. Badly damaged, soiled and torn items are not accepted.
2. Donations are not always accepted due to lack of storage, volunteers to receive them, inclement weather or pending inclement weather.
3. If the driveway gate is closed during normal store hours, it's a strong indication that donations of any kind are **not** being accepted.
4. There are **NO EXCEPTIONS!**
