CAMPING RULES & REGULATIONS

Campers and guests on the grounds of the Phelps Fire Department must follow these rules and regulations for the safety of themselves and all others on the grounds. The Phelps Fire Department and/ or local law enforcement reserves the right to require any person(s) to leave the grounds if inappropriate behavior is observed or the safety of others is compromised due to that person(s) activity.

Payment of the camping fee constitutes agreement with these rules & regulations. The Phelps Fire Department is not responsible for accidents, injuries, loss of money/personal property, or damage to campers, vehicles, or personal property.

- 1. Your camping space must be paid for before a site is assigned. Your camping permit must be in a visual location on the front of the camping unit. All parties camping on the grounds must be registered with the Phelps Fire Department.
- 2. The camping fee is a fixed rate of \$300 per site. Your camping permit is valid from 3:00pm Saturday, April 6th 2024 until 11:00am on Tuesday, April 9th 2024. No refunds will be given to campers/guests that arrive late or leave early.
- 3. All campsites are 25 feet x 50 feet. A minimum of 10 feet open clearance is required between camping vehicles. Sites ARE NOT provided with water, sewer or electrical hookups. Dry camping only.
- 4. Limit of 1 vehicle and one camping unit per site. All others must park in overflow parking. The entries, passages, driveways, parking lots, roads and other common appurtenances shall not be obstructed or encumbered nor used for any other purpose than ingress and egress unless otherwise specifically designated by Phelps Fire Department.
- 5. All black and gray water holding tanks must be empty upon arrival. All dump/sewer valves must be in the off position and capped. Absolutely no discharging of any water on the ground. A dump station is being provided onsite for all campers to use at no additional charge.
- 6. Fresh water will be available onsite to fill your fresh water supply tank.

7. Operation of generators is permitted between the hours of 8:00am and 9:00pm.	
8. Campground speed limit is 10 MPH at all times.	
9. Pets must be controlled by a leash. Pets must be cleaned up after always. Pets are not to be tied up outdoors left alone at the site. Pets brought to the campsite must be non-aggressive toward humans and other pets. Vaccination records must always be available.	
10. Fireworks are not permitted.	
11. Fire are permitted only in a contained fire ring and must be maintained less than 3 feet in height. Do not burn trash. Fire rings must be located within your site and in front of your camper. Fires cannot be located between camping units. Fire rings are NOT provided by Phelps Fire Department. Unsafe fires will be extinguished if necessary.	
12. Guests shall dispose of garbage in dumpsters provided.	
13. No motorized recreational vehicles (ATV's, UTV's, golf carts) are allowed in the park.	
14. All campers and guests must leave the property by 11:00am on Tuesday, April 9 th 2024. Sites must be cleaned of all trash and debris.
