MT. LION BASEBALL DROP GAME AT HOME TO TYGARTS VALLEY 8-4

PARSONS – The Tucker County High School Baseball team hosted Tygarts Valley on Tuesday May 25th for the last game of the regular season. Tucker County lost the lead late in the game and fell to the Bulldogs 8-4 on Senior night.

Pitching was strong for both teams as Matthew Pratt threw 6 innings for Tygarts Valley, while Mason Kisamore was on the mound for Tucker County for 7 innings. Kisamore allowed just 4 hits, walked 2 and struck out 11 batters. Kisamore also collected his 60th strikeout of the season in the game. Zack Colebank entered the game in relief for the Mt. Lions in the 8th and 9th inning.

The game was close as Tucker County broke a 2-2 tie in the 5th inning as Kisamore drove in 2 runs on a 3-2 count with 2 outs as he singled to right centerfield to score Blake and Maddox Anderson. This gave the Mt. Lions the 4-2 lead. Tygarts Valley rallied in the 7th inning as they tied the game a 4-4 after Tucker County committed 3 errors to help the Bulldogs comeback. This forced the game into extra innings where Tygarts Valley then pulled away as they scored 4 runs in the 9th inning for the 8-4 victory.

Blake Anderson, Ethan Rosenau, Mason Kisamore and Trenton Wilfong each collected hits with Wilfong drove in 1 run and Kisamore drove in 2 runs.

Zack Colebank ended the regular season of his senior year with 3 homeruns, a batting average of .400 and 19 RBI's. Gus Mullenex also ended the regular season of his senior year batting .333 with 11 RBI's. Mason Kisamore ended the regular season with a .489 batting average with 18 runs batted in, and 21 stolen bases. Trenton Wilfong batted .366 on the year with 1 homerun and 7 RBI's and 14 stolen bases. Maddox Anderson rounded out the top five in batting for Tucker County with a .264 batting average with 6 RBI's and 14 stolen bases.

The Mt. Lions were scheduled to start double elimination Sectional play at East Hardy on Tuesday, June 1.
