



"Yuma's Community Veterans Home!"

-WHO-

Right Turn for Yuma Veterans is a Transitional Housing Program for homeless or at-risk of being homeless veterans. The program is administered by Child & Family Services of Yuma, INC, a non-profit that has been serving families in the Yuma, Community for 35 years.

-WHY-

Yuma has long needed a place where homeless Yuma Veterans can receive housing as well as service coordination.

Our veterans program provides a warm, comfortable home for them while they address their barriers to independence.

-WHAT-

Right Turn for Yuma provides housing, life-skills training, group counseling and coaching for up to six homeless veterans at any given time. We also provide classes in personal budgeting, weekly group therapy sessions with a licensed clinical worker, and one on one coaching during a weekly scheduled meeting, and on an as needed with the Program Manager. The homeless veterans in our program are assisted with identifying and addressing the problems which they must resolve in order for them to function as independent and contributing members of society. There are typically one or more of three main areas that are at issue with homeless veterans. Those issues are lack of sufficient income to maintain housing and living expenses, medical and/or social difficulties that prevent successful employment and integration into the community, and a lack of natural support systems within the community.
