



AT LARGE MEMBER POLICY

Adopted 10/27/2016

- The Lumberjack RC&D Council, Inc. shall approve up to seven (7) At Large representatives to serve as Council members
- At Large members have full voting privileges
- At Large members may not be an elected or appointed county official
- Each county is encouraged to nominate At Large representatives for consideration
- No more than two At Large members will be allowed from any one county
- To be considered for At Large membership, candidates must complete either a *Nomination Form* or a *Continuation Form* depending on their situation (see attached forms)
 1. *Nomination Form*: New At Large members must complete section I and their nominator must complete Section II.
 2. *Continuation Form*: Current At Large members who wish to continue must complete a new form for each term.
- If more people apply than the seven (7) allowed, the Council will hold a secret ballot
- Terms are two years and beginning in April of 2017, At Large members are elected in opposite years from the County's bi-annual Board Elections
- Upon approval as an At Large Council member, expenses related to attending approved meetings and Directors and Officers Liability insurance coverage will be paid by the Council (See LJ Council Member Expense Reimbursement Policy)
- This policy coincides with Lumberjack ByLaws Article IV - Council
- This policy may be changed as deemed necessary at any time by a majority vote of the Council
