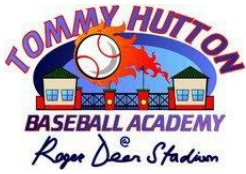
Tommy Hutton Baseball Academy Announces PB Cardinals Skipper Oliver Marmol as Director

The Tommy Hutton Baseball Academy is thrilled to announce that Mr. Oliver Marmol has accepted an offer to become its Director.

Marmol, 29, is in his first season managing the Palm Beach Cardinals. Prior to taking the helm in Palm Beach, Marmol was Manager for the State College Spikes, a class-A affiliate of the St. Louis Cardinals. He made his professional managerial debut in 2012 with the rookie-level Johnson City (TN) Cardinals and led the club to the Appalachian League playoffs, one of three St. Louis affiliates to reach post-season play last season. His debut as a skipper in the Cards' farm system came just one year removed from his first coaching job, working as the hitting coach with the rookie Gulf Coast League Cardinals in 2011. A former middle infielder in the Cardinals minor league system, Marmol was drafted in the sixth round of the 2007 Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft out of the College of Charleston in South Carolina. Marmol went on to play four seasons in the Cardinals player development system from 2007-10, finishing his career with the High Class-A Palm Beach Cardinals in 2010. He batted .203 with five home runs and 68 RBI, while stealing 42 of 55 bases in his minor league career.

THBA's founder and general manager Brian Justine said: "We are proud to have Oliver taking over the day-to-day leadership of our programs. His enthusiasm and passion for the game of baseball will no doubt have an immediate impact on our instructional camps and clinics. Having a coach of Oliver's caliber accessible to the youth baseball community is uncommon to say the least. We are thrilled to have him as our new leader as we enter our sixteenth year serving the community!"

When asked about this opportunity, Oliver said: "I am excited for this opportunity to be a part of the Tommy Hutton baseball camp. My wife and I have been wanting to get involved in the local community for a while now and when this opportunity was presented we were really excited to jump on board. I'm looking forward to bringing a high standard of skill to youth baseball while also keeping it fun. When you are able to keep that balance we have found that you get maximum results. I am honored to be a part of such a reputable program and look forward getting to know all the kids and their families."
