Date: Tuesday, July 3, 2018

Place: McConnell-Talbert Stadium Parking Lot (across from Warner Robins High School)

Time: Gates open at 6:00pm

Tickets: Free! No ticket required!

Entertainment: Country Star Hunter Hayes live on stage!

Fireworks: Following the concert, enjoy the largest fireworks show in event history! It is a pyro-musical, which means the fireworks are set to music. The shells are electrically fired so that they go off in sync with music. There are over 3000 shots in our show! The shells weight over 2000 pounds! It takes 30-40 hours to choreograph and pack the show.

Concessions: There will be food and beverage concessions available for purchase inside the venue. No outside food may be brought into the venue.

Road Closures: 3PM - Demon Valley Drive will be closed to ALL vehicular traffic to include parking. 10PM – South Davis Drive closed during fireworks show.

Parking: Parking maps will be published in The Telegraph week of the event. Limited Handicap parking will be available with a valid state-issued handicap parking pass only.
