

Elks Drug Awareness Video Contest

The theme for 2018-2019 is:

“Drugs Take Away”

Rules:

The contest is open to three age groups:

Pre-High School (Middle School)

High School

Post Graduate

Participant may be an individual or group

Video must be 2 to 5 minutes in length

Format must be Flash Drive or similar “mobile media” in readable format

Judging will be based on the following:

Closeness to the theme

Neatness

Originality

Age and Language appropriate

Positive message

Quality of video

The entry must include the following information on the back of the poster.

Please print clearly.

1. Student's full name

2. Student's address

3. Student's phone number (Elks winning entries will be notified)

4. School, Location, grade and Teacher's name

5. Name and number of sponsoring Elks Lodge

6. Must also be accompanied by Hold Harmless Agreement

7. Must also include Video Contest Entry and Parental Release Form

This is a 2-page form. All persons under 18 must have parents signature.

Please read form carefully. Grand Lodge will not accept incomplete forms.

Due Date:

All entries must be submitted to your local lodge by February 1, 2019 to be judged.

Winners:

Each Elks Lodge will select the top videos using the criteria listed above. The winning video will then be forwarded to State Level Competition. All winning entries become the sole property of the State Elks Association, and may not be returned. You may want to make a copy of the video before sending it.

Lodges will be responsible for giving their own awards.

The State Drug Awareness Committee will choose the first, second and third place State winners in each category. First Place will receive a \$50 check, Second Place a \$25 check and Third Place a \$25 check. Prizes may vary depending on number of entrants. (Total Prize Value is \$300). The three First Place winners will be judged and the Overall Winner will be submitted for entry into the National Contest and may be featured on the www.elkskidszone.org website and/or in ENF and DAP Publications.

There will be one National Winner in each category who will receive a gift certificate from the Drug Awareness Program (value = \$300).
