Service Job Description

Service Position: Intergroup Service Representative (ISR)

Length of Service: 1 – 3 years

Qualifications: 12 months regular attendance at meeting
12 months of not incurring unsecured debt
2 Pressure Relief Meetings

Duties:

1. Attend Intergroup monthly meetings
2. Inform Intergroup about D.A. publications and GSB activities and committee action steps
3. You share with Intergroup your overall perspective based on the 12 Steps, 12 Traditions, and 12 Concepts of Service that you draw from your experience with other groups and members worldwide
4. Attend the annual World Conference
 - a. Represent the MN Intergroup at the annual World Service Conference as a voting delegate
 - b. Participate on a Conference committee of your choice, and if you choose a caucus of your choice and work with that committee throughout the year to carry out its Conference-approved action steps
Committees: Business Debtors Anonymous (BDA), Conference (CC), Fellowship Communications (FCC), Hospitals, Institutions, and Prisons HIP), Internal Operations (IOC), Literature (LITCOM), Public Information (PI), Resource Development (RDC), and Technology.
Caucuses: address concerns of Diversity, Intergroup and International
 - c. Report to Intergroup on activities and action steps of the Conference
5. As primary contact, your name and address and other contact information should be sent to the General Service Office (GSO). Mailings for Intergroup from the GSO will be sent to you.
6. You should confirm – once a year - that Intergroup's registration with the GSO is current and the information about meeting locations and times are accurate and up to date

Estimated time commitment per month: 2 – 4 hours

Notes:

1. It is recommended that the GSR is familiar with and practice the 12 Steps and 12 Traditions. Also, the GSR should become familiar with the 12 Concepts of Service (as outlined in the General Service Manual)
