SAMPLE BACKFLOW VALVE INSTALLATIONS IN CREEKSIDE

Creekside has had sample backflow valves installed at several residences in its community by a different contractor than the one we chose. Three are clustered around 21326 Via Colombard and a fourth is in front of 756 Crocus. You can drive by and take a look at them to get an idea as to what ours will look like with the freeze bag in place. There are large signs identifying the sample installations. One caveat is that these installations may not be exactly like the ones our contractor will install, but should be close enough for you to get an idea. Check it out.

SAFETY & WELFARE NOTES

A few safety tips from the U.S. Fire Administration:

- * Don't overload electrical outlets or extension cords.
- * Properly maintain chimneys and keep anything that can burn at least 3 feet away from space heaters.
