

Sugar Grove farmer's market opens 2020 season

The annual Sugar Grove farmer's market opened its 2020 season Saturday, June 6. The market continues from 8 a.m. to noon Saturdays through September at the village hall parking lot, 10 Municipal Drive in Sugar Grove. Admission and parking are free.

Transitioning from a community gathering event, the market is among offerings becoming transaction-based, in-and-out markets due to COVID-19 restrictions.

Shoppers are asked to wear face masks, follow CDC hygiene practices and maintain six-foot social distancing between other shoppers, market staff and vendors.

Other guidelines for shoppers include pre-ordering products, using credit and debit cards and washing products at home before using.
