THE ABSOLUTELY TRUE SCIENCE OF NERDS will feature themed-numbers from stars of the New York City burlesque scene, such as the legendary Jo "Boobs" Weldon and rising-sensation Tiger Bay, along with science and nerd culture celebrity interviews as well. Every show will feature a different guest appearance!

THE ABSOLUTELY TRUE SCIENCE OF NERDS was first performed at the Nerd Nite lecture series at Galapagos Art Space in Brooklyn, NY in 2009. It has since been seen at Global Nerd Nite, the 92nd St Y, TEDx, C2E2, in Toronto, and as the closing presentation at the Smithsonian Institution's 2014 Future is Here Festival, alongside such luminaries as physicist Brian Greene, astronaut Mae Jemison and George Takei.

The Absolutely True Science of Nerds

For a good time in the world of superheroes, galactic empires and savage costumed beasts ("kaiju"), look no further than Shyaporn Theerakulstit's clever performance lecture *The Absolutely True Science of Nerds*. *It's so good, so scientific, it's just plain hilarious*.

The show analyzes three cultural phenomena: *Batman, Star Wars* vs. *Star Trek*, and *Godzilla*. During the thorough evaluation of each topic, many tools such as PowerPoint and rap are used to boldly prove what has never been proved. But in case you're a real nerd, you'll appreciate the reminder that many Bothans died to bring us this information (see: *Return of the Jedi*) and the stirring tribute to those peripheral characters which is accompanied by Sarah McLachlan's song "I Will Remember You".

It's nerdy and yet when I was there seemed enjoyable for anyone, even those born this century.

Batman is a hyper-educated superhero out to avenge the murder of his parents in Gotham City's Crime Alley (a crime that was unsolved for many years despite the wealth of crime scene footage). Shyaporn shows us how he trained for one week to simulate Batman's workouts, caloric intake, sleeping habits, etc. 1960s chic such as Adam West dancing and the music of Mingus abounds. Next comes a loving comparison of the technology in the *Star Wars* (a long time ago) and *Star Trek* (near future) universes. If you don't know already, you will find out which is better, hyperdrive or warp drive. You will speculate on which is bigger, the Federation or the Galactic Empire. You will imagine which story has better robots and more humane distribution of wealth. The results may shock you.

After an interlude from a guest burlesque dancer (I got to see Zelma Zelma as Ensign Redshirt), we wax nostalgic over the many times Godzilla has almost destroyed our civilization. We of course review how nuclear testing awakened the dormant kaiju, and speculate what type of dinosaur Godzilla and his ilk are. There are also thoughtful tips on how to survive a Godzilla attack, e.g. "run" and "don't live in Japan".

It is always a pleasure to see a funny, mind-altering show like this. If you have ever used the Force (whether in physics class or for the betterment of the world) you will have a great time. You may even try to stump Shyaporn during the Q&A, but his comic timing and authoritative style are most admirable.

LISA RAMACI REVIEWS "THE ABSOLUTELY TRUE SCIENCE OF NERDS"

Created, produced and performed by Shyaporn Theerakulstit

I start this review by confessing that I am a nerd. When I was a little kid I wanted to grow up to be a Vulcan so I could marry Spock; I've seen "Star Wars" 272 times IN THE THEATER; and my #1 current TV show is "Big Bang Theory". So when I heard there was going to be a Fringe performance incorporating lectures about Batman (THE best DC superhero), Star Trek and Star Wars, and Godzilla, King of the Monsters, I knew I had to see it.

As performed totally straight-faced by Shyaporn Theerakulstit in the guise of a college professor, the 90-minute production was a mix of comedy, pseudo-science, an impressive and inventive Power Point presentation, and a deeply disturbing striptease, complete with swinging boob AND butt tassels, executed by a buxom babe in a Godzilla costume (but at least she depicted the lizard from the 1998 bomb, not the endearing chubby-faced one from the Tojo Studios).

The lecture topics covered "How to Become Batman", "Star Wars vs. Star Trek" (a conversation I've had more than once in my life, but Theerakulstit and I differ on the outcome), and "Godzilla: History, Biology and Behavior of Hyper-evolved Theropod Kaiju", and each was a learned discourse, accompanied by charts, graphs, film clips. There were also songs and a bit of soft-shoe accompanying the Batman and Godzilla lectures, ably performed by Theerakulstit.

So if you want a thorough dissection of how many martial arts Batman knows, and how many calories a day he gets to eat, as well as a fabulous cutaway rendering of the Bat Cave ("Batman: Origins and Training" and "Secrets of the Dark Knight Detective"), or spirited comparisons of the weaponry, propulsion systems, mystical elements and starships from the Star Trek/Wars universes ("ST vs. SW: Modern Perspectives of Past Future and Future Future Technology"), or an overview of the rise, and history, of my favorite atomic superbeast Gojira, hurry to see one of the four remaining shows of "The Absolutely True Science of Nerds".

There's lots of laughs, some interesting visuals (with the exception of those butt tassels), and a chance to see an extremely intelligent dork utilizing his acting, singing and dancing abilities to great effect in what is obviously a personal salute to things he clearly cherishes.

The only down side to the show was the audience - while they obviously appreciated Mr. Theerakulstit's efforts, they failed miserably to cooperate during the Q&A sessions following each lecture, with only two of us trying to ask questions. So to all of you future viewers - when it comes time to query Mr. Theerakulstit, in the immortal words of Captains Kirk, Jean-Luc Picard and

Janeway - "Engage"!
