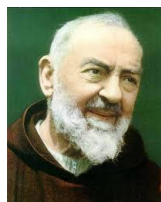

A Short Bio for Fr. Joseph Peter Illo

Fr. Joseph Illo was born in the Bronx, New York, in 1961. He received a B.A. in English Literature from the Pennsylvania State University in 1983, worked at Ignatius Press in San Francisco and then studied at Blackfriars Studium, Oxford (England) before completing a philosophy degree at the Dominican University of St. Thomas ("the Angelicum") in Rome. He received an M.A. in theology from St. Joseph's Seminary in New York and was ordained to the priesthood for the Diocese of Stockton, CA, in 1991.

He has served in four parishes, one term as vocations director, and two years as chaplain at Thomas Aquinas College in Southern California. He is currently pastor at Star of the Sea parish in San Francisco. He has worked with Mother Teresa's Missionaries of Charity for fifteen years, giving retreats and seminars to them around the world. He belongs to two priestly fraternities, the St. John Fisher Society, and the Corpus Christi Movement for Priests of Mother Teresa, of which he serves as North American Counselor.

Fr. Illo enjoys all outdoor sports, especially backpacking, skiing, cycling, kayaking, and snow camping. He especially treasures his brother priests, and all the good people from the assignments in which he has served.

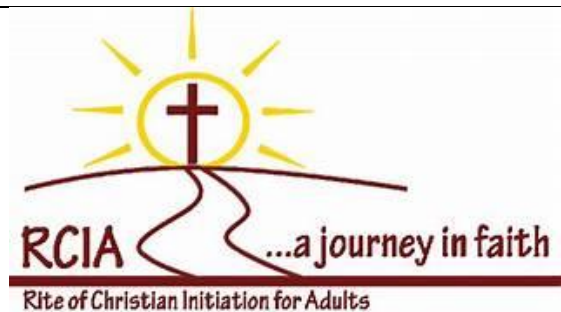

In the early church, there were various little ceremonies that prepared catechumens for Baptism at the Easter Vigil. In the Second Vatican Council, the Catholic Church recovered the importance of these ceremonies. Three of those ceremonies are called "Scrutinies."

The Scrutinies

First-- Wednesday May 30 at 6:00 PM

Second-- Wednesday June 27 at 6:00 PM

Third-- Wednesday August 15 after the 6:00 PM Mass

The Spiritual Purpose of the Scrutinies:

"The scrutinies are meant to uncover, and then heal all that is weak, defective, or sinful in the hearts of the elect; to bring out, then strengthen all that is upright, strong, and good. For the scrutinies are celebrated in order to deliver the elect from the power of sin and Satan, to protect them against temptation, and to give them strength in Christ, who is the way, the truth, and the life. These rites, therefore, should complete the conversion of the elect and deepen their resolve to hold fast to Christ and to carry out their decision to love God above all." (§141 in *The Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults*)
