#### **Public Forum**

Alderman Short announced the Public Water District has put in a booster pump on Highpoint. This increases fire flow in the rest of the city. Short also announced Tom Gourley finished a three year review from DNR and it was "Good".

PARK BOARD VACANCY. Still posted.

APPROVE AND OR DISCUSS BIDS FOR PLUMBING SERVICES FOR CITY HALL AND MAINTENANCE BUILDINGS. Four bid requests mailed, Buffalo Reflex, and on website. One bid received from DeLong Plumbing.

**Motion** by Bowman to accept bid from DeLong Plumbing. Second Foley No discussion. Short aye, Foley aye, Gourley aye, Ault aye, Bowman aye, Miller abstain (relative works for DeLong Plumbing).

### PLANNING AND ZONING UPDATE ON COMPREHENSIVE PLAN.

Ault, Planning and Zoning representative announced P&Z thought the cost to have Comprehensive Plan done professionally was cost prohibited since it was not in the budget. Ault and others on P&Z thought they could maybe do it themselves. Mayor stated having a well written, updated Comprehensive Plan is a must for economic development. The last Comprehensive Plan was done in 1993. Miller agrees plan gives value to what the community wants. Ault stated getting a plan is high priority for the Planning and Zoning Commission. Foley does not think a comprehensive plan is needed. SMCOG working with the city to get cost down from \$12,000 to \$16,000 to \$5,500. Most plans cost around \$16,000. SMCOG will use a grant to offset cost. Bowman wants Plan done as soon as possible.

Motion by Ault to amend agenda to include a vote to approve a Professional Services Contract with Missouri State University (SMCOG). Second Bowman. No discussion. Foley no, Short aye, Miller aye, Gourley aye, Ault aye, Bowman aye.

Motion by Ault to enter into a Professional Services Contract with MSU and SMCOG for Comprehensive Plan. Second Bowman. Discussion: Short asked if Ault thought Planning and Zoning would be upset if the Board went ahead an approved contract.

Ault stated no. Ault thought P & Z would be glad to have help on the Plan. After Plan is professionally done Planning and Zoning Commission will keep it updated every few years. Foley no, Short aye, Miller aye, Ault aye, Bowman aye, Gourley abstain-do not have enough information, not educated enough to make decision. Motion passes 4-2.
