Money will be distributed to a vast majority of local charities. Currently funded programs (see attached sheet for details) include; Ryan's Wish, Health Initiative Cancer Services Program, Hospice and Palliative Care of St. Lawrence County, Massena Memorial Hospital, Center for Cancer Care at Canton Potsdam Hospital, Winter Cancer Treatment Center, and Jewels of Life Foundation. The organization prides itself on the fact that ALL proceeds remain in St. Lawrence County to benefit our friends and neighbors. The need for those important programs increases on a daily basis.

**Event Details:**

- Entry fee is **\$20 per participant**.
- Each participant will receive a race kit, including: event t-shirt, sunglasses, temporary tattoos, and more!
- Participants are encouraged to wear white shirts or the event t-shirts, in order to make the colors as vibrant as possible.
- Participants may run or walk starting at 1:00 p.m. on event day.
- The Partridge Run Golf Course is a 3.2 mile loop that winds around the Partridge Run Golf Course. The main entry for the event is off of Sullivan Drive next to the golf course parking lot that doubles as trailhead parking.
- On day of event, registration will begin at 12:00 p.m.

### Programs Funded by the St. Lawrence County Cancer Fund

- ☐ **Ryan's Wish Foundation-** Provides assistance to families and individuals as they travel to cancer treatment appointments. Recipients receive gifts of gas cards, money for hotel stays, help with regular maintenance of vehicles for travel, funds for medical co- pays and help with medications not covered by insurance. In 2018, Ryan's Wish helped 170 families and distributed nearly \$75,000 to help with cancer related expenses. The need for this program increases daily.
- ☐ **Hospice and Palliative Care of St. Lawrence Valley-** Funds from the St. Lawrence County Cancer Fund are used to provide cancer patients with an in- home visit with a nurse practitioner from the Advanced Illness Management (AIM) team. Cancer patients typically need assistance managing the symptoms of their disease, however, while receiving treatment, there are limited programs that can offer support. AIM staff is trained to support Oncologists and treat the many issues cancer patients face while fighting their disease. This funding will provide support to 180 cancer patients in 2019.
- ☐ **Massena Memorial Hospital-** Hosts monthly Skin Cancer Screenings which are free to the community. MMH will also support the offering of educational seminars including Colorectal cancer awareness, Melanoma cancer detection and awareness, Ovarian, Uterine and Breast Cancer and lung cancer will be provided free of charge throughout the community.
- ☐ **Canton- Potsdam Hospital-** Using funds from SLCCF, the Center for Cancer Care provides transportation for residents who are receiving treatment at their facility. Their vehicle dedicated to transporting patients logs more than 20,000 miles each year and is used sometimes daily by their patients. Additionally, they will expand their Navigation Program to include a Financial Counselor. With this position in existence only a short time, it has saved patients hundreds of thousands of dollars and helped to ease anxiety when dealing with the financial aspect of a cancer battle.
- ☐ **Claxton- Hepburn Medical Center-** In 2019, CHMC will partner with CHMC physicians and will provide 6 free colonoscopies. Additionally, they will offer 10 low- dose CT lung cancer screenings and a clinic to provide 10 high- risk breast cancer screenings. The Richard Winter Cancer Treatment Center will also purchase a new electronic chemotherapy infusion chair to provide patients with physical and mental comfort while they receive treatment with the help of the St. Lawrence County Cancer Fund.
- ☐ **Jules of Life-** With the support of the St. Lawrence County Cancer Fund, Jules of Life created and maintains a website used as a central resource for anyone battling cancer. The website has information on treatment centers locally and across the country. In addition to treatment centers, they provide resources for emotional support, financial assistance and information on the many issues those facing a battle with cancer encounter.
