3. Go out quickly into the streets and alleys of the town and find those who are in need.

Most of the unchurched prefer to attend church on Sunday morning if they attend.

"If I attended church, it would be the only time I could go regularly," said Al V. of Tulsa.

"I work five days a week, and I like to go home to my family at night. And we almost always have some activity that one of our kids is involved in on Saturdays. I just think Sunday is the best time. And Sunday morning is the best time, because we get the kids to bed at a decent hour on Sunday night." Just think of the implications for a sec – it is estimated that 160 million people in the United States are unchurched (if we define unchurched as attending church two or less times in a year.)

If this research is anywhere close to accurate, then the implications are staggering: **Over 153 million people would start attending church if they were invited!**
