Mayor Candidate Denny Laufenburger and City Council Candidates Andrew Aller and Dan Campion use Chanhassen High School Booster Club to Further Political Gain Jeopardizing Tax Exempt Nonprofit Status and also put Chanhassen High School and Eastern Carver County School District at Risk.

Mayoral Candidate Mark Senn said today "these individuals have clearly put political gain in front of good taste, common sense, and the laws governing Fair Campaigns Practices in Minnesota". Senn has tried to keep this information from harming the Booster Club and the School District. Further attempts to protect the district has lead Mayoral Candidate Mark Senn along with City Council Candidates Peter Adolphson and Michael Leonard to file Unfair Campaign Practices Complaints today against Laufenburger, Aller and Campion. Peter Adolphson said, "None of us really wanted to do this and put a blemish on these races or the City of Chanhassen, however, people must be informed and aware of the kind of people ... seeking leadership positions in the City of Chanhassen." "The arrogance of these candidates is outrageous" Mike Leonard said. "At best this is extremely poor judgment. At worst this is a callous disregard for good people and organizations for political gain". Senn said, "You can't use these organizations or our children for political gain. This has to stop here and now".
