I would like to take this opportunity to thank members of the Dayton Darting Association for your support and confidence expressed in electing me president of the DDA. The task for 1984-85 will be monumental. We begin with a financial and communication dilema never before equaled. The growing pains of the DDA will force a restructuring of the administrative and executive organization. I would like to implement more detailed fiscal controls and responsibilities. We need, and I propose, a more thorough and clear line of communication at all levels of the Association.

I have a detailed program to submit to the Board members for approval. A brief outline of my program is as follows:

- 1. Fiscal responsibilities
 - a) Submit a 1984-85 budget
 - b) Initiate double entry ledgers
- 2. Computer assisted scheduling, point posting, and mailing list.
- 3. Restructuring of playoffs
- 4. Restructuring of Dayton Dart Open to increase participation of local members
- 5. Designate assignments and responsibilities of Board members
- 6. Selection of ADO representative

It is with great dismay that I report an accounting of the 1983-84 finances reveals a deficit of over \$1500.00. Due to the lack of proper records and entry of all Association business transactions, the exact location and reason for the deficit cannot be pinpointed. It is known the poor turnout for the Dayton Dart Open may contribute to a large portion of the deficit. The financial records will be further studied to account for all income and expenditures for the past year.

In spite of the unfortunate financial situation, the DDA will prepare a program for the 1984-85 season. The past season will be reviewed and discussed, and restraints may be necessary in certain programs to maintain a healthy and viable Association. You will be kept informed on the progress of our financial situation.

Your support and willingness to help will be needed in the next year, and if we unite and work as a team, we can overcome our obstacles. I look forward to, and wish you all, a super 1984-85 dart season.

<u>SPECTACULAR SINGLES CHAMPS - DeWOLF</u> and KARPOWICH

The Lucky Strike Filters Spectacular in Columbus, Ohio June 1, 2 and 3 attracted approximately 400 participating darters vying for the \$21,000 purse. A darting first in Region IV was a Dart Workshop Friday. All darting principles were covered by JUDY CAMPBELL, 1983 North American Open Womens Singles champ; SANDY REITAN, rated number one in the world by the World Darts Federation; JERRY UMBERGER, 1983 Lucky Strike Triple Crown of Darts Most Valuable Player; RICK NEY, 1984 US Open Singles champ; CONRAD DANIELS, member of the 1983 World Cup team and 1984 Nation's Cup team; DAN PUCILLO, World Cup, World Masters and Nation's Cup team member from 1979 to 1982. Videotapes of darting competition were also informative to the group of 50 registrants.

JERRY DeWOLF took the measure of the highly rated JERRY UMBERGER in a lack—lustre Singles final. The first leg started like a barnburner when Umberger hit a T80 and DeWolf countered with a T40. After the first throw, a trip 20 was as rare as hen's teeth. Failure to hit the outshots by both finalists gave DeWolf a second opportunity to sneak out 20 and 21 dart games, and take the best two of three for the Singles championship.

KATHY KARPOWICH, a free-wheeling filly from Freeland, PA unnervingly placed darts in tight groupings at the numbers she shot. The bounceouts did not affect her outcome. HELEN SCHEERBAUM had kept the score respectable but in each leg errant darts slipped into the one bed. In each leg Kathy hit her outshot in one and two throws for 22 and 23 dart games.

JULIE SULLIVAN and KATHY KARPOWICH blasted through six rounds without losing a leg to win the Womens Doubles. Runnersup KATY CASSILLAS and SANDY REITAN were whipped in two straight. The tension and strain of the finals had both pairs shooting scared, but the mark of a winner is hitting the doubles which Julie and Kathy just didn't miss.


MD CELEBRITY DART BENEFIT




