

## Joyce F. Burke Academic Excellence Scholarship 2019-2020 Scholarship Program Guidelines

### Dear Applicant:

We founded **The Belton Foundation**, a non-profit 501c (3) organization, as a way to give back to the community. As an advocate for youth in our community, it is our desire to lend a helping hand to youth interested in continuing their education. Through its programs, our foundation strives to enrich the lives of youth through educational programs and to promote healthy living lifestyles for cancer prevention.

The Joyce F. Burke Academic Excellence Scholarship was established for students interested in attending an accredited four-year university. The Belton Foundation will award (2) two \$1,500 scholarships, (2) two \$1,000 scholarships, and (10) ten \$500 scholarships to assist students in their educational endeavors. Funds can be used to supplement the cost for school tuition, books or room and board fees. All checks will be made payable directly to the university/institution.

Students that meet the scholarship criteria should apply for this opportunity. Applicants will be notified by Friday, March 6, 2020 on the status of their application. Scholarships will be presented on Saturday, May 30, 2020 at the 6<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Glitz & Glamour Gala from 6pm-10pm.

Students must meet the following criteria and submit the following information to be eligible for the scholarship:

 Applicants must complete the scholarship application in its entirety, along with supporting documents, and submit via mail to:

- Applicants must already be accepted to any accredited four-year university (and have proof in the form of an official letter on letterhead from the school).
- Applicant must be registered for Fall Semester of 2020 with at least a minimum of 12 hours
- Applicants must be residents of Dallas-Fort Worth (or surrounding areas in the Metroplex)
- Applicants must use the social media tool kit provided upon receipt of scholarship to post about The Belton Foundation and being a scholarship recipient.
- Applicants must be able to be filmed or photographed for documentation purposes.
- Applicants must be present at the 6<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Glitz & Glamour Gala on Saturday, May 30, 2020 from 6pm-10pm. (Location will be disclosed in acceptance letter)



## **Supporting Documents Needed:**

- Applicants must provide the following supporting documents:
  - An official, sealed school transcript.
  - Applicants must be a (graduating) senior in high school and have a 3.0 or above G.P.A.
  - (2) Two letters of recommendation (at least one from a teacher or counselor).
  - A personal essay (500 words or less) describing your educational goals and how this scholarship will help you achieve those goals.
  - An official letter of acceptance (on letterhead) from your accredited four-year university.
  - Applicants must be able to meet on a mutually determined time/place to claim their monetary gift from the foundation.
