Presentation by Jim Hickey: Jim reviewed for the Board the contract from previous years with Keowee Key showing ownership of property by Marina Villas and Keowee Key and responsibilities for maintaining same.

YTD Financial review: B. Dougherty discussed capital improvements including painting and paving. Dougherty stated the Operational budget is on target.

Capital expense is over by \$3,000 due to trees. Insurance is over by \$500. Landscaping is on budget. G. Lee is waiting on the irrigation quote. Capital assessments are due May 1, 2022.

2022 Major Initiatives: Maintenance:

Crawlspace Inspections: G. Lee stated there are 4 buildings left to be inspected.

Dryer vents: G. Lee stated there are 6 more pair of vents that have been designated for replacement. still vinyl. The Board agreed to hold off for now thru April spending.

Chimneys: 2 chimneys will be repaired after the rainy season, late April or early May.

Work completed and work to do:

- 4 doors to paint. 338 requires 3 coats.
- 315/317 plumbing leak repaired.
- L. Maxwell's unit does need a dehumidifier and will follow up with remediation from unit above.
- Inspect leak at 241.
- Touch up painting and unpainted wood needs completing.

T. Morse had requested from the Board information on water shut offs at the four meters. This is a KKUS issue. They will come and turn off the water, but it would be good for owners to have water meter turn off keys.

Walk around: April 8th at 10:00 a.m.

Window cleaning: Shiny Blinds will be scheduled to clean windows the 1st week of June if possible. P. Muehling will coordinate.
