Next on the agenda was the Report of Committees. Membership & Retention, Shipmate Phillipp reported that as of August we have 68 members with two members for renewal.

Shipmate Rauch went over the July Financial Statement and supporting reports and Shipmate Kaider made a motion to accept the report that was audited by the Audit Committee Trustee, Shipmate Mathews seconded and all approved.

Unfinished or Deferred Business. 1) Shipmate Kaider reported the Annual Washington Commanders Raffle overall results and are displayed to the left. 2) Shipmate Rauch reported that the National Convention half page Journal Ad Request was sent on July 26, 2022. 3) Reminder that the National Convention Meals & Special Events submissions are due by October 5, 2022. New Business. 1) Shipmate Rauch submitted an FRA Triangle Branch 182 Bylaws Resolution to delete Article VII, Section 701 from our Bylaws pertaining to the Petty Cash Fund. This will be reviewed at the next two Branch meetings and voted on at the October meeting. 2) Due to the National Convention taking place the week of our October Branch meeting, Shipmate Phillipp made a motion that we have our Branch meeting on Wednesday, October 26, 2022 and the Annual Triangle 182, Inc meeting to be held on Wednesday, November 16, 2022 preceding the Branch meeting, Shipmate Kaider seconded and all approved. No other new business.

Good of the Order was held and then at 1950 a motion was made to adjourn the meeting, seconded and approved. Next meeting will be on September 21, 2022 at American Legion Post 86 and via Zoom.

The FRA sponsors an annual essay contest to promote the spirit of Americanism and Patriotism among our country's youth. FRA's Americanism Essay Contest is open to all students, grades 7 through 12, including those who are home schooled. Students are invited to submit a 350-word essay through an FRA member or local FRA branch before the December 1st deadline. Local winners are forwarded for competition at the regional level and regional winners compete for national prizes.

The grand national winner will receive \$1,500, with additional prizes for the top three essays in each grade category (\$1,000 for first place, \$750 for second place, and \$500 for third place). Each national winner will receive an attractive plaque citing his/her achievement, and every entrant judged at the national level receives a certificate of recognition. Additional prizes may be awarded to students winning at local and regional levels of competition.
