In their first vote, Mayor Papan and council member Rodriguez supported Planning Commission Vice Chair Ellen Mallory while council members Bonilla and Goethals voted for Amourence Lee. In the second vote Papan changed her vote for Lee. While Mallory had the greatest experience of the candidates, Lee's alignment with the pro-growth agenda of Bonilla and Goethals appeared to sway the day.

We will all get a chance to vote on candidates for this position in November 2020, so make yourself familiar with the candidates now to make an informed vote.

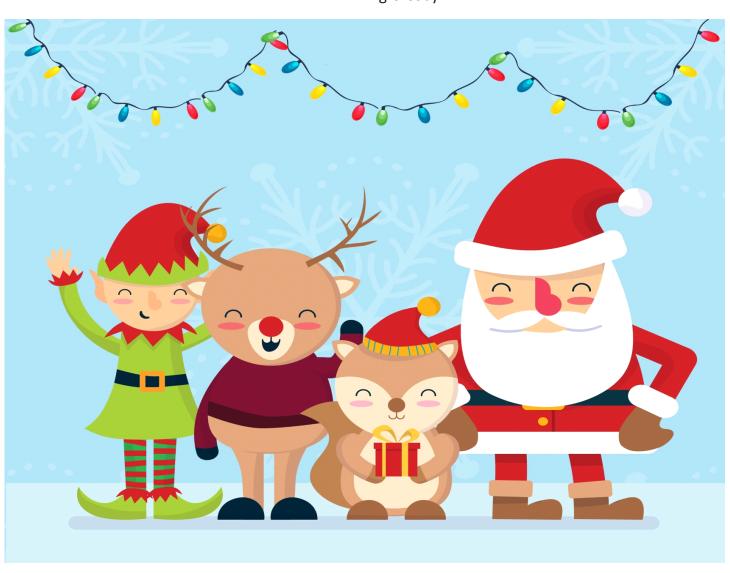
