


The Competition . . .

Each team will be challenged to complete a variety of activities — like puzzle assembly, cup stacking, bottle flipping and dressing in surgery gear. When a task is completed, the team will be given a gold coin, which a team member must run to their pot of gold at the far side of the field. The team will then tackle the next challenge, earn a second coin, and so forth.

The first team to successfully complete their tasks and return their full pot back to the judge will be the winner.

Form Your Team . . .

Teams will compete against others of the same category. Challenge neighborhood families, co-workers or local businesses to join you for the Pot of Gold Relay Race!

Teams fall into six different categories:

- **Adults:** Four adults ages 18 or more.
- **High School Students:** Four teenagers currently enrolled in high school.
- **Families:** Up to two adults and children up to the age of 17. Team may have between 3-7 members.
- **Young Families:** Up to two adults with children ages 3-12. Team may have between 2-6 members.
- **Local Heroes:** A team of four individuals who serve as fire fighters, law enforcement officers, EMTs, in the military or ROTC, Boy or Girl Scouts, or similar groups.
- **Special Needs:** A team of four individuals who have special physical, emotional or behavioral needs.

Relay Details . . .

- **Check in begins at 9 a.m.** Please bring identification.
- **The first heat begins at 10 a.m.**
- Teams should wear matching shirts so they can be easily identified.
- All teams, except for family teams, must have four members.
- Each team must complete all of the activities, regardless of the number of members.
- Each team member must complete one full leg.
- Families with young children and special needs teams may have designated runners.
- Family teams with more than four members may choose who will run, but no member may run more than once.
- Family teams may work together on the activities.
