
WE HAVE EXCITING NEWS!

CHLORINE TABLET PROGRAM

Once again, we want to remind property owners with sand filter septic systems of the importance of adding chlorine tablets to the chlorinator once a month. Over the past several years the LBA has emphasized the importance of proper septic system maintenance and have provided chlorine tablets at no cost to those needing them. The LBA wants to continue providing these tablets, but due to the rising costs, we need to charge \$2 per tablet.
