***HOTY: Results count towards the ESA HOTY annual awards

Advanced Freestyles 2019

The EADC has recently become aware of a contradiction in the test sheet for the Advanced Freestyle (1/1/19) and the Directives for Freestyles in the current Rule Book (Section 8).

Movement 12 on the Advanced Freestyle test sheet reads:

Flying changes of lead every 4th and/or 3rd stride – minimum 3 times consecutively.

Whilst Table 8.12 in Section 8 showing "Examples of movements of a higher level deliberately shown" was amended to reflect the test directives, Rule 8.6.1 (d) was not at the same time changed.

Clearly this was an oversight for which we take responsibility and apologise sincerely for any confusion this has caused amongst riders and/or officials.

With our riders in preparation for the Australian Dressage Championships, we wish to make urgent clarification that the intent of the change was to give riders a opening to increase the "degree of difficulty" in their freestyle choreography – and to be rewarded accordingly.

As the Table 8.12 clearly outlines what movements are and are not acceptable in Freestyle across the levels, Rule 8.6.1 is in fact redundant and has been removed accordingly.

Dressage Judge Activities Update

Judge Education Opportunities

A reminder about dates for Dressage Judge Seminars for the rest of 2019. All judges, riders, coaches and observers welcome (no charge).

- 1. <u>C / D seminar on 9th November (Saturday)</u> with Susie Hoevenaars (FEI 5*, Nat A & JE) at Cromwell Park, Verdun. Registration 8:30 am for a 9:00 am start.
- 2. Protocol Day with Susie Hoevenaars on 10th
 November (Sunday). We are so fortunate to have an FEI 5* judge available for one-on-one rider training in the setting of a dressage competition. Details will be posted on Facebook and Nominate soon. This is also an opportunity for judges to practice their judging and listen to the feedback from Susie.

Dressage Masterclass is presenting **an evening with Ingrid Klimke** on Saturday 15th February 2020. From young horses to Grand Prix, this will be a great event for all dressage riders and judges.

Dressage by the Sea at Willinga Park will be hosting Dorothee Schneider for a Master Class on 27th February 2020. This is in conjunction with the FEI Regional Dressage Forum, which was last held in Australia in 2005. Register at https://willingapark.com.au/spectator-tickets-dbts/.

The ESA Dressage Judges Committee (ESADJC) is working on the calendar for 2020 and we aim to provide a seminar for each level each year. In 2020 we will also run a seminar for Young Horse judges on January 19th with Jane Ventura, a highly respected FEI 4* Judge, FEI HY judge and EA YH Judge Educator. Jane will also be judging on Saturday 18th January at MCDC.

Young Horse Judges – SAVE THE DATE: Seminar with Jane Ventura on Sunday January 19th 2020.

Other News:

The ESADJC recognises that there are considerable costs incurred by judges to maintain accreditation or upgrade to a higher level. The Committee is updating the Judges Education Subsidy, to enable judges to apply for a subsidy to cover the costs of travel to Interstate events when accrediting and upgrading. We hope this will help increase the number of judges in SA, and encourage our existing judges to both upgrade and continue their education. We are still working on budget allocation for the amounts available from the Judges' Levies and the application process. Details will be released soon.

A very successful E / F / G seminar was held on 1st September, with theory at the ESA Office and demonstration riders at Tilling Hill. Thank you to Liz Duncan and Barrie Stratton for presenting the Seminar and to the riders who generously gave their time to ride the Preliminary, Novice and Elementary tests for the judges.

Congratulations to Brigitte Drinkwater, who attended the E / F / G seminar. She has completed all the requirements and is now an official G level judge. Well done! We look forward to seeing Brigitte judging at events around SA.

The DSAWP came together in the beginning of 2019. During this very short and at times bumpy period the team have worked hard to promote events, gain communication with Clubs, maintain the Horse of the Year awards and Performance Medallions and put a State Squad in place.

DSAWP put in place an online application this year for the Dressage State Squad which worked well and made the process much easier for our selectors Liz Duncan and Wendy Hunt. There were over 40 applications across all Senior and Young Rider squads with very positive applications. You can check out the Squad riders on the Equestrian SA website Dressage page. SA has some exciting horse and rider combinations to watch out for in the coming year.

The Dressage Youth Development weekend held at Kirkcaldy Park in January 2019 with dressage coach Dirk Dijkstra and selector Prue Copping was a great success with each of the riders showing improvement over the weekend. The feedback from both coach and selector on the behavior, sportsmanship and care the young riders provided their horses was encouraging. The next generation is shaping up to be a good one!

The Horse of the Year awards are very exciting to follow and are available on the Dressage SA Facebook page to see where riders are sitting on the mid-year Leaderboard. 2019 Australian Amateur Owner Rider Championships – It's A Wrap! Personal perspectives from our South Australian Competitors Program

Lorraine Wohling and Forever Royal MEDIUM CHAMPIONS!

It's 3 am and with our playlist ready to rock we were packed and on the road to Boneo - that's me, Heather (my biggest supporter and chief navigator — thank you!), Kurley (aka Forever Royal, an important part of the team!), Poppy (our much loved pooch, driving supervisor and lookout!), our picnic hamper and thermos flask of tea. After a fairly good run we hit Melbourne, only to be stuck in traffic off the Westgate Bridge with a broken-down truck in the Burnley Tunnel. But with nowhere to go but forward and a colourful CB radio commentary to keep us amused, we stayed in our lane and even emerged with both mirrors still on the truck (always a bonus). Perhaps it was this feeling of achievement that set us up for a great comp!

I have only been to Boneo a few times and just once before to compete, but even after the long drive, I was feeling both nervous and excited! It is a fabulous venue, equal to some of the best in the world. The facilities are enviable with a dynamic team and a progressive vision. Not to mention a fantastic restaurant – *Arilla* – that overlooks the main Dressage and Show Jumping arenas and serves beautiful food and wine – we can definitely recommend the scallops!

Kurls settled into his stable and was quick to become BFFs with Melissa Boekel's big beautiful Jaffa and after setting up camp we had our first ride! It was uneventful, calm and enjoyable and I dared to think Kurls just might be maturing! As we settled in for the evening it was a great opportunity to meet new people from all over the country, talk "big rigs" (wow, those NT people know how to travel) and catch up with fellow campers Ann and Nic for a relaxing glass of bubbles.

Day one of the competition and I was finally able to realise a dream and wear my tails in an official competition! I bought them in 1993 at Burley Horse Trials and even though they were not the latest fashion I was determined to wear them and wear them we did! Unfortunately I made some silly and costly rider errors, but we still managed 6th place in the Advanced and 3rd in the Medium, and among the strong competition I was stoked.

After a busy first season of Showjumping for 5 yo Lamperds Stella, I made the last minute decision to enter the AOR Dressage Nationals at Boneo Park. It was a 3.30 am start and we arrived at Boneo Park from Adelaide late on Thursday afternoon, saddled up and headed straight for the practice arena for a quick stretch before dark. The extreme wind, together with the super spongy arena footing made for a very non-relaxing, electrified experience. I think my words to my husband were, "Oh S#*t, we should've arrived yesterday, but it's a bit late now!"

On Friday morning, much to my delight the sun was out and both Stella and I couldn't have been more relaxed. I had texted Cooper Oborn in New Zealand the night before about a suitable warm up routine, to which Stella responded to a treat. She gave me such a fabulous feeling that I didn't even bother to check the scores so as not to put a dampener on my mood. I couldn't believe it when Cooper texted me to say "You'd better check the scores - you're 2nd on 66.8%!!"

On Saturday I was the first rider in the arena, making me unusually nervous - I knew I was nervous as I could only stomach half my usual bacon and egg sandwich for brekky. I suspect Stella felt my nerves as she spooked in a rather dramatic fashion at the frogs croaking in the pond behind the arena approximately 30 seconds before we entered our test. Regardless, as we turned down the centreline we regained our calm focus and she gave me another ripping ride for 68.2% and 4th place, finishing off our weekend as Novice Reserve Champion.

Day two and we refocused! We are still very new to riding at Advanced level, but were determined to improve on our previous score. After navigating the busy warm-up arena, complete with people being coached and seemingly oblivious to others, we presented to the Judges and had our time. Everything comes up very quickly in the 5C and we had to recover after a slight communication glitch, but at the end of the day both Judges had us in first place and we were on cloud nine with 69%! With the Advanced done we focused on the Medium 4C and pulled off 2nd place, giving us the Medium Championship! Wow – excited, shocked, proud and all smiles! What better reason than to go and spend some money at the Chaballo stand (thank you for supporting the event Dale and Chaballo!) and have another glass of bubbles!

If you are thinking about making the trip to this event, it is worth it. It was great to share the experience with fellow South Australians, meet new people, enjoy a friendly supportive environment and see everyone get so much out of the experience. I personally learnt a lot and we will be taking our experience into our next competition!

President's Report

You should all be aware by now of the new EA Concussion Policy rule. Basically if anyone falls from their horse anywhere on the grounds at a competition they must report to the Clubhouse for a CRT5 Tool assessment by the Designated Person before continuing to ride. Upon recognition of suspected concussion, the rider will be removed from further competition. The Organizing Committee is required to notify in writing both the person and the National Safety Official at Equestrian Australia. Please do not take offense at the organizing Committee if you are involved in an incident. We are only following the National Protocol to which we must comply.

If no concussion is suspected then the rider may continue to ride.

If there is a suspected concussion then the rider will have to provide a medical clearance from a GP before being allowed to compete within 6 days if over 18 yrs and 14 days if under 18 yrs.

Horseland Mt Barker are the Elite Sponsors for the Spring Dressage Festival again this year. We are very grateful to them and to all our Sponsors for their support . They make this prestigious event possible and we ask that the winners of classes ensure that they send a Thankyou to the relative Sponsor and also support them when ever possible.

Our best wishes to Gerry Wellington for a speedy recovery from her unfortunate accident and sympathy to both Gerry and Jo Taylor on the sad loss of their beautiful horse 'Bliss'.

More sad news was the passing of Cecile Buckton after a long fight with cancer. Our sincere sympathy to her family from all of us.

- To be able to look at the competition results during an event you will need to download the "Nominate Scoreboard" app.













