Purpose. The Craig Tribal Association, a federally recognized tribe, is recruiting for an Environmental Technician. This is a full-time, seasonal ending on 8.15.24, non-exempt position. The primary function of this position supports the Craig Tribal Association's Environmental Program, by assisting in the preparation of essential program plans, quarterly IGAP reporting, conducting water quality and habitat and biological data collection. This position is required to work in all types of outdoor field conditions and work non-traditional work schedules.
