Pentecost: "What does this mean?"


Acts 2: 1-12

¹When the day of Pentecost arrived, they were all together in one place. ²And suddenly there came from heaven a sound like a mighty rushing wind, and it filled the entire house where they were sitting. ³And divided tongues as of fire appeared to them and rested on each one of them. ⁴And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit gave them utterance. ⁵Now there were dwelling in Jerusalem Jews, devout men from every nation under heaven. ⁶And at this sound the multitude came together, and they were bewildered, because each one was hearing them speak in his own language. ⁷And they were amazed and astonished, saying, "Are not all these who are speaking Galileans? 8And how is it that we hear, each of us in his own native language? ⁹Parthians and Medes and Elamites and residents of Mesopotamia, Judea and Cappadocia, Pontus and Asia, ¹⁰Phrygia and Pamphylia, Egypt and the parts of Libya belonging to Cyrene, and visitors from Rome, ¹¹both Jews and proselytes, Cretans and Arabians—we hear them telling

in our own tongues the mighty works of God." ¹²And all were amazed and perplexed, saying to one another, "What does this mean?"

Pentecost, which marks the arrival of the Holy Spirit after Christ's ascension, is a day of surprises and wonder. A "mighty rushing wind" came from heaven and tongues of fire descended upon Christ's followers and they were filled with the Holy Spirit. The Spirit is described as the Helper, the Comforter, The Spirit of Truth, guiding Jesus' followers after His departure.

How thankful we are for the living, daily presence of the Holy Spirit in our lives!
