- 3) Submit a letter of acceptance to either a trade school or an Institute of Higher learning.
- 4) Submit an Essay of 250 -500 words (typed, double spaced) discussing "How my experiences with cattle have prepared me for future life experiences"
- 5) Submit a letter of Recommendation
