(food for thought) (Bulletin 1 January 2023) Gospel: Luke 2:16-21. "Whose Child is this?"

As with the shepherds keeping watch, our faith journey to the feet of the infant Godmade-man in the manger always leads us to a choice. We are faced with many roads along the way. The road to the manger leads to the road of discipleship, then to the road to Calvary, and finally to the road of resurrection and the empty tomb. The choices we make along this journey are those that can enable us to bring Christmas to completion.

This is the real meaning of Christmas. We celebrate not just a past event, but a present reality. We look to the motherhood of Mary to remind us that this Child is a Child of our own.
