The Jefferson Township Trustees Require the Road Superintendent to Attend Training Classes and then Obtain Required Licensing for Spraying of Vegetation Kill and Application of Other Lawn Fertilization Products in Jefferson Township and Obtain Licenses Before the 2017 Spring Season.

The Board of Trustees of Jefferson Township, Montgomery County, Ohio met in regular session on the 3rd day of January 2017, at the Township Offices located at One Business Park Drive, with the following members present:

Trustee McGuire moved the adoption of the following resolution:

WHEREAS, The Jefferson Township Board of Trustees desire to have the Road Department Superintendent to be licensed for controlling the high weeds that occurs in the Township; and

WHEREAS, The Township have made a commitment to cleaning up the Township and its right of way areas, parks, and Cemetery Properties; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Jefferson Township Board of Trustees and the Township Administrator to make sure that appropriate licensing and credentialing is maintained by the Superivors that are required to perform their assigned duties.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Jefferson Township Board of Trustees requires the Road Superintendent to attend training classed and then obtains a Spraying License and Application of lawn Fertilizer License for applying chemicals in and around Jefferson township right of ways, and in the Cemetery and Park Systems.
