### **Sharing Gifts Projects**


Thank you to all who took a few blocks or pillowcase kits home during our January meeting. Quite a few of the sewn blocks have come back already – thank you very much.

*Mindful Meandering* by Laura Lee Fritz, C & T Publishing. The sub-title says '132 Original Continuous-Line Quilting Designs' and that's all you need to know. Very useful for a freemotion guilter - or even a hand guilter!

What an interesting book. The designs are modern, and the author tells you how to create your own. Her approach to cutting and piecing is by hand, combined with that close, straight-line machine quilting. She has an interesting way of hand quilting that avoids knots. It's worth a read for the different approaches.
