Resort Guidelines

- All debris and garbage must be placed in the containers provided.
- · Loud noise which may distract from fellow member's rest is prohibited · Motorized vehicles such as golf carts or four wheelers are allowed, from 10:00 PM until 9:00 AM.
- Members must clean general grounds surrounding their campsite after
- PETS MUST BE KEPT ON A LEASH AT ALL TIMES and UNDER THE CONTROL OF THEIR OWNER or kept inside the member's RV. ALL

MEMBERS/GUESTS MUST PICK UP ANIMAL WASTE DAILY-NO EXCEPTIONS! Pets may not enter buildings or swimming pool areas under any circumstances. Noisy or vicious pets are not allowed. If an animal is unruly, the member must leave the Resort

- TLC Wolf River Resort members and guests use all facilities at their own risk and TLC Wolf River Resort is not responsible for loss or damage to property of members and/or guests. Anyone under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
- Members may cut only downed or dead firewood at the resort as
 Camping vehicles must not be left unattended overnight without prior permission from the camp host or resort manager
- Members must park in an area designated for recreational vehicles only. ABSOLUTELY NO washing of RV's and/or vehicles while parked on campsite or on campground.
 - but drivers must be at least 16 years of age and obey all speed limit signs and stay within the natural borders of the road. Any vehicle driven after dusk must use lights.
