

Clarification to Club By-laws:

Article XIV, Section I: Amendment process, #4

Current By-law Article XIV, Section I: Amendment Process, #4 requires **“An Amendment must be approved by two-thirds (2/3) of the total membership.”**

This statement is ***clarified*** by the next line in this section as it states very clearly that:

- a. If a member is not able to attend the meeting where the final vote is to be taken, the Member’s ballot must be signed and returned *for his/her vote to be counted.***

Clarification:

Our own by-laws are clear that votes cast in person at the meeting where the final vote is taken **AND** votes signed and returned out of the total membership of club members, are to be counted. This means 2/3rds of the votes received are needed to pass an amendment to the bylaws.

It is the boards recommendation that the members accept the above clarification of the By-law rule.
