NEWS:

FRIDAY/MONDAY: This **Fri, Sep. 1** is a 12:30pm dismissal, and there is no school on Labor Day.

KINDNESS SHIRTS: Students should wear their Kindness Shirts on **Tue, Sep. 5** with school uniform bottoms (i.e. shorts or skirts/jumpers). If you requested another shirt, the shipment will arrive soon and we will send the shirt home with your child.

HANDBOOK AMENDMENTS: Two amendments have been made to the 2023-24 Parent/Student Handbook; Health section on Page 8. Changes are noted in red:

- 1) If a child is running a fever, the parent must come to the school as soon as possible and within 30 minutes.
- 2) If a child is diagnosed with head lice, he/she must be completely lice-free before returning to school.

CROSS COUNTRY: We would like to find out if students in grades 3-8 would be interested in participating on a Cross Country team to represent our school. If we have enough interest, students will have the opportunity to train with two of our parent volunteer coaches who grew up running track and field and have knowledge and training to offer to our students.

Students would have the opportunity to participate in up to 3 meets (middle school only) between Sep. and Oct., competing against other local parochial schools. The first meet would be Sep. 12 or 13, a second meet at the end of September, and one more in October.

Team will consist of 3rd-8th graders for training purposes, but only middle school will compete in the meets due to the length of the course. Most middle school XC courses are two miles which is developmentally not appropriate for anyone younger than 6th grade.
