#### 2017 Summer Youth Baseball & Softball Programs Info

#### **Traveling Baseball Leagues**

**ROOKIES:** Boys in 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> grade (COACH pitch, Friday evening games)-emphasis on equal participation and skill development

MINORS: Boys in 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> grade (Beginner PLAYER pitch, Friday Games)-emphasis on increasing skill development

**LITTLE LEAGUE**: Boys in 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> grade (PLAYER pitch, Friday Games)-emphasis on advanced skill development, position specific player development and team competition

**GRADERS/PONY**: Graders - Boys 14u - (PLAYER pitch on 90' diamond, Friday and Sunday Games)-emphasis on advanced skill development and position specific team concepts to prepare players for High School level competition (1 Chilton Team) – Graders players will also play Pony league games

*Pony* - Boys in 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade (PLAYER pitch on 75' diamond, Tuesday and Thursday Games)-emphasis on advanced skill development, position specific team concepts and increased competition (2 Chilton Teams)

\*Coaches will select players for GRADERS team – Pony teams will be split to equally divide talent\*

**Dates**: Practices start in April with games starting in early May through July

\*There will be an end of season tournament for all leagues\*

**Place**: Nennig Park **Cost**: \$100 each player Graders/Pony \$75 each player all other leagues

Late sign-up Fee: \$125 each player Grader/Pony \$100 each player all other leagues -- after March 4th

\*Jerseys and Hats will be provided for all baseball leagues. Practices and game times determined by coaches

### **Traveling Softball Leagues**

**C League:** Girls in 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> grade (COACH pitch, Sunday Games)

**B League:** Girls in 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> grade (Beginner PLAYER pitch, Sunday Games)

A League: Girls in 7th and 8th grade (PLAYER pitch, Sunday Games)

Practices start in April with games starting in early May through July

Place: Nennig Park Cost: \$75 for each player Late sign-up Fee: \$100 each player after March 4th

\*Jerseys will be provided for all softball leagues. Practices and game times determined by coaches

#### Tiger Cubs Non-Traveling League

Boys and girls (co-ed) in Kindergarten, 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> grade. Basic fundamentals of throwing, catching, hitting from a tee, and running of bases will be the main focus of this league. There will be 2 practice dates along with 2 scrimmage/game dates. Lots of volunteers are needed to run this so feel free to help out if you can.

Cost: \$25 for each player

- \*A parent/guardian must attend a mandatory information meeting which will be scheduled before the start of leagues
- \*Each player and parent in either baseball/softball program is required by law to read, sign and return a **Concussion Acknowledgement Form** along with registration form.
